

DOCTORAL PROGRAMS IN EDUCATIONAL ADMINISTRATION



ISU currently offers two doctoral programs through the University Center: a PhD in Educational Administration with a concentration in Higher Education Administration and an Ed.D in Educational Administration with a P-12 Administration Concentration. In both cases, ISU offers only one cohort at a time. Future programs will be statewide weekend/blended cohorts held at Illinois State University. A minimum of 60 hours of coursework beyond the Master's degree and 15 dissertation hours is required for either degree.

PHD PROGRAM IN EDUCATIONAL ADMINISTRATION (HIGHER EDUCATION ADMINISTRATION)

TARGET AUDIENCE:

Designed for higher education faculty, staff, or agency personnel with master's degrees who are pursuing careers in higher education administration or research. Examines how college and university leaders assess and reframe organizational structures, policies, and cultures in ways that maximize learning opportunities for diverse students.

DELIVERY MODE:

A statewide weekend cohort began in Fall 2009 and will end in Fall 2013. Students meet for courses on ISU's campus for 4 weekends per semester. In between, students and faculty continue their work online in synchronous and asynchronous formats.

ED.D IN EDUCATIONAL ADMINISTRATION (P-12 ADMINISTRATION CONCENTRATION)

TARGET AUDIENCE:

Designed for educators who hold master's degrees from accredited institutions, Type 75 certificates, and some building or district leadership experience (department chair, dean, assistant principal, principal, central office staff, director, union leader, program director, subgroup leader, or other related duties). This concentration leads to Superintendent's endorsement, and, if one chooses the right electives, the Chief School Business Official endorsement.

DELIVERY MODE:
