Graduates who meet all requirements and receive certification from the state are entitled to work with children from birth through age 8 and to teach Pre-K through Grade 3 in Illinois public schools and similar organizations that require certification. Three degree tracks are offered to suit your needs.

TARGET AUDIENCE:

Individuals with recent coursework in ECE from CLC or other accredited institution whose career plans include working in Illinois public schools.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- Admissions application with \$50.00 application fee and completed personal statement
- All official college transcripts (transfer students with less than 24 quarter hrs. must also submit high school transcripts.
