Scholarship Policy

The University Center of Lake County awards a scholarship/fellowship to students who reside or work in Lake County and who are pursuing their graduate program in mental health at a University Center member university.

All fellowship recipients will be required to participate in a mentoring program, attend monthly professional development training, and will be invited to attend the Scholarship/fellowship Awards Ceremony, if unable to attend the recipient should arrange for a representative to attend in their place.

The full tuition assistance amount shall be paid directly to the bursar/financial aid office of the school the student is attending and will be applied towards tuition and fees.

Fellowship Eligibility Requirements

To be considered for a University Center of Lake County scholarship, you must meet the following criteria:

- Must be interested in working in mental health and social behavioral services in Lake County.
- Must be a graduate student.
- Accepted into a University Center Member's University Graduate program offered at or through the University Center.
- Submit a 300-word essay on future goals, the significance of being a mental health counselor, or social worker, reasons for pursuing this career, school-community connections, and what it means to be a University Center student.
- Provide two letters of recommendation. **These should be typed on letterhead stationery, signed, dated within the current academic year and included with the application packet.**
- Must be available to participate in University Center outreach and professional development activities.
- Reside or work in Lake County.
- Include the most recent college transcripts.

How to Apply

To apply, please do as follows:

1. Download Fellowship Application from www.ucenter.org.
2. Fully complete the application, attach required documents, and scan as a PDF.
3. Send Transcripts
4. Proof of admission to the University Center Council Member university of your choice.
5. Submit ONLY two typed letters of recommendations provided by people not related to the applicant on letterhead, with an original signature, and dated within the current academic year. Letters not to exceed one page.
6. Submit a 300-word essay on future goals, the significance of being a mental health counselor, or social worker, reasons for pursuing this career, school-community connections, and what it means to be a University Center student.

Please Note: It is the student's responsibility that all documents are sent to the University Center of Lake County as required and in a timely manner. Incomplete applications packets or packets received after the deadline will not be notified about missing documents.

How the Scholarship is awarded:

- A selection committee, made up of University Center Board members and Executive staff of the University Center, will review the fellowship applications.
- The committee will apply the included rubric to qualify the applicants.
- The highest scoring students will be awarded fellowship.
- Incomplete applications will not be given consideration.
- The winners will be officially notified by the University Center Executive Director and Dean.
- The fellowship money **will be sent directly** in two payments to the school of the student's choice. The first payment will be sent at the beginning of the fall semester, and second payment will be sent at the beginning of spring semester. Students must have a passing grade and be in good academic standing for second payment to be released. Payments will be sent directly to the University where a student is enrolled.

- Winner(s) will be required to submit a photograph and short bio for posting on the University Center’s website, scholarship page, and other promotional materials.
