Scholarship Policy

The University Center of Lake County awards a scholarship to students who reside or work in Lake County and who are pursuing their undergraduate / graduate program at a University Center member university.

All scholarship recipients will be invited to attend the Scholarship Awards Ceremony, if unable to attend the recipient should arrange for a representative to attend in their place.

The full scholarship amount shall be paid directly to the bursar/financial aid office of the school the student is attending and will be applied towards tuition and fees.

Scholarship Eligibility Requirements

To be considered for a University Center of Lake County scholarship, you must meet the following criteria:

- Accepted into a University Center Member's University Undergraduate or Graduate program offered at or through the University Center.
- Submit a 300–500-word essay telling us about yourself and describing why you are returning to school, describing your future goals, leadership, community service, and what it means to be a University Center student.
- Must be available to participate in University Center outreach activities.
- Provide two letters of recommendation- These letters should be typed on letterhead stationery, signed, dated within the current academic year and included with the application packet.
- Reside or work in Lake County.
- Include the most recent college transcripts.

How to Apply

To apply, please do as follows:

- Download Undergraduate and Graduate Scholarship Application from www.ucenter.org.
- 2. Fully complete the application, attach required documents, and scan as a PDF.
- 3. Send Transcripts.
- 4. Proof of admission to the University Center Council Member university of your choice.
- 5. Submit ONLY two typed letters of recommendations provided by people not related to the applicant on letterhead, with an original signature, and dated within the current academic year. Letters not to exceed one page.
- 6. Submit a 300–500-word essay telling us about yourself and describing why you are returning to school, describing your future goals, leadership, community service, and what it means to be a University Center student.

Please Note: It is the student's responsibility that all documents are sent to the University Center of Lake County as required and in a timely manner. Incomplete applications packets or packets received after the deadline will not be notified about missing documents.

How the Scholarship is awarded:

- A selection committee, made up of University Center Board members, will review the scholarship applications.
- The committee will apply the included rubric to qualify the applicants.
- The highest scoring students will be awarded scholarships.
- Incomplete applications will not be given consideration.
- The winners will be officially notified by the University Center Executive Director and Dean.
- The Scholarship money will be sent directly to the school of the student's choice.
- Winner(s) will be required to submit a photograph and short bio for posting on the University Center's website, scholarship page, and other promotional materials.
